Guidelines for Participating in Context Education Network (v.1.0)

We'll keep it simple and clear. There are a few guidelines for participating and providing content to the Context Education Network and all its sub networks:

Important Guidelines

First and foremost: Be courteous!

This is a community network and as with any community everyone needs to feel safe and validated. It is OK to disagree but it is not acceptable to use disparaging language or making demeaning remarks. This is our prime policy and failure to adhere may result in temporary suspension of your account with a warning, or total ban, depending on the severity of the case.
